Listen to the sound of weeping as the water flows over shingle. The water is said to be the tears of two brothers who mourn their sister who drowned at the river mouth.

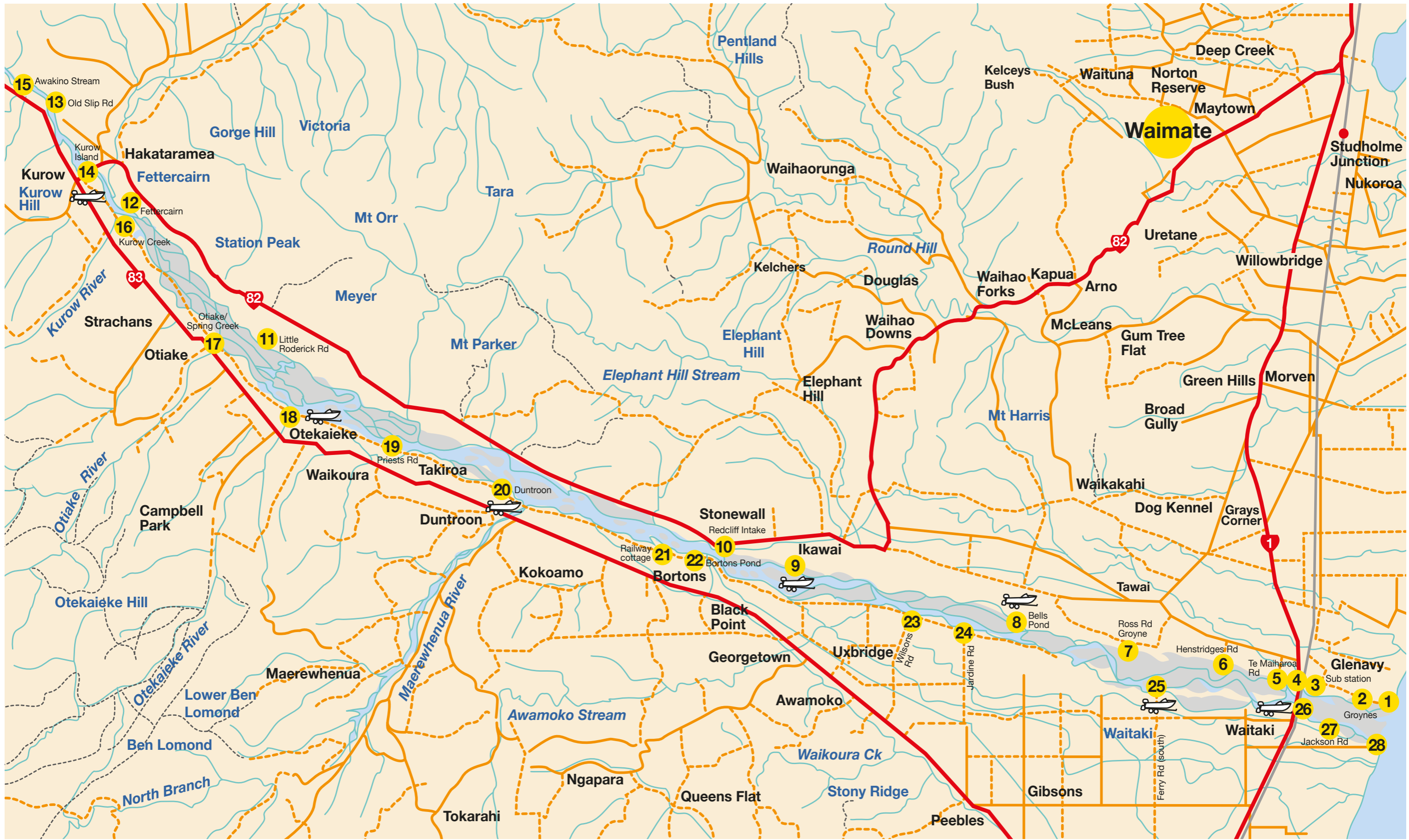
- Enjoy your outdoor experience.
